## **OPWDD CARE AT HOME (CAH) WAIVER PROGRAMS**

**Program Information:** 

- 1) <u>State Plan Medicaid (MA) Services:</u>
  - Child receives a MA card & is eligible for MA services including MD offices, hospitals, pharmacies, equipment, etc. via a NYS MA provider
  - MA will also cover Nursing or Consumer Directed Personal Assistance Program (CDPAP) services if authorized by the appropriate deeming body
- 2) Monthly CAH Case Management (CM) Services:
  - Monthly face-to-face CM visits
  - CM agencies certified by State DOH; 6 agencies in the FL area
- 3) <u>Respite Services:</u>
  - If appropriate, in-home respite services are covered under CAH
- 4) Out of Home Respite Services:
  - Up to 30 days overnight respite/year; above 30 days requires approval
  - Includes therapeutic recreation services that are billed as respite it they are outside the home setting
- 5) Environmental Modifications/Assistive Technologies:
  - If approved via the DDRO process, various items can be approved including van lifts, ceiling tracks, bedroom & bathroom modifications, home accessibility, widening of doorways, & generators
- 6) <u>Community Health Nurse (CHN) Visits:</u>
  - CHN home visits 2x/year minimum for 6 month reviews
  - Can be more if needed/deemed necessary
- 7) <u>CAH Coordinator Oversight & Annual (Minimum) Review:</u>
  - Annual (minimum) visit & assessment by CAH Coordinator to establish CAH eligibility; completed with caretakers, Case Manager, & CHN (PRN)
  - CAH Coordinator provides oversight of all CAH program services
